	The aim of this program is to support an undergraduate student, graduate student, or post-doctoral researcher for the oral presentation of their research at the CCIC Cannabinoids in Clinical Practice Meeting June 22-23, 2023 in Toronto, ON.
General eligibility criteria:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Applicants must be trainees (undergraduate, graduate students, and postdoctoral fellows).2. Applicants must be CCIC Trainee members.3. Only one application per year per applicant.4. Applicants must share in the vision, mission and purpose of the CCIC.5. Successful applicants will recognize support from the CCIC by acknowledging the funding support of the CCIC.
Specific eligibility criteria:	Applicants must: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Be a registered trainee at a University or Research Institute (e.g. Hospital) at the time of application.2. Be engaged in cannabinoid or cannabinoid-related research.3. Be able to attend the 2023 Cannabinoids in Clinical Practice meeting June 22-23, in Toronto, ON
Required documentation:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Poster Abstract application form – 2 pages fully completed.2. Abstract (<250 words + all authors and affiliations, funding sources acknowledged) of research to be presented.3. A letter signed by the applicant and his/her supervisor confirming the relationship and that the applicant will present the abstract submitted.
